EXPLANATORY NOTE

The disposal of ground lease rights to the Region of Peel for a period of 99 years for the purpose of the co-location of a Region of Peel Paramedic Station and a City of Brampton Fire Station 211

Through a market-value based lease and cost-sharing agreement, the Region of Peel plans to utilize about 0.7 acre of a newly acquired City property on which the paramedic station will be built, adjoining the new City fire station.
