

DISPOSITION OF LAND

Transfer of Permanent Easement to Hydro One Brampton Networks Inc. Williams Parkway, east of Main Street

Pursuant to By-Law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus and dispose of the following easement rights over municipal property:

LANDS AFFECTED

Part of Blocks A and O on Registered Plan M-152
Calvert Park – south side of Williams Parkway, east of Main Street and
Valleybrook Park – north side of Williams Parkway, east of Main Street

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Transfer of permanent easement to Hydro One Brampton Network Inc. for the construction and maintenance of a feeder cable, switch gear and all related works over Parts 1 and 2 on a draft reference plan prepared by David B. Searles Surveying Ltd. as File No. 58-0-11.

Pursuant to By-law 191-2011, surplus declaration may be made by Delegated Authority. In this case, authority is delegated to the Commissioner of Community Services and the City Solicitor for the following circumstance:

- Surplus declaration for property or rights to be conveyed to a utility for installation/maintenance of services, or for property or rights to be conveyed to another government;
