

**SURPLUS DECLARATION AND INTENT TO SELL LAND**  
**Transfer / Release of Vista Block to the Adjacent Property Owner**  
**Upperlinks Drive**

**PURSUANT** to By-law 160-2004, take notice that the Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus and dispose of the following municipal property:

**LANDS AFFECTED**

Block 201 on Registered Plan 43M-1713 (vista block)  
City-owned vista block adjacent to 52 Upperlinks Drive

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

Surplus declaration is required to effect the transfer of the vista block to the adjacent property owner of Lot 36 on Registered Plan 43M-1713, as the vista block is no longer required for municipal purposes.

The City's Delegation of Authority By-law 191-2011, authorizes delegation of authority to the City Solicitor and the Commissioner of the operating department, in this case, the Commissioner of Community Services, in connection with the following Real Estate related activity:

- Surplus declaration for property or rights with current market value of \$50,000 or less where surplus declaration was not instigated by potential purchaser(s).
- Disposal of surplus property or rights at current market value of \$50,000 or less to adjacent property owner(s) who is/are sole potential purchaser(s) where disposal was not instigated by potential purchaser(s).

A plan of the affected land is available for review in the City Clerk's Office at the address below during normal business hours.
