

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO STOP UP AND CLOSE, DECLARE SURPLUS AND DISPOSE OF PORTIONS OF THE EXISTING CREDITVIEW ROAD, FAIRHILL AVENUE AND THE FORMER HIGHWAY 7

PURSUANT to By-law 160-2004, take notice that The Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to stop up and close, declare surplus and authorize the disposal of the following municipal properties:

Parts 1, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12, 13, 14, 17, 18, 21 and 22 on the draft reference plan with Drawing No. 09153r02b, dated October 19, 2011.

In addition, the City intends to declare surplus and dispose of portions of the buffer blocks, lying on the east side of the existing Creditview Road on both sides of Fairhill Avenue, being Parts 15, 16, 19 and 20 on the draft reference plan, as well as portions of land lying along the west side of the existing Creditview Road, north of Bovaird Drive, being Parts 2 and 3 on the draft reference plan.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

With the imminent opening of a new portion of Creditview Road, north of Bovaird Drive, certain portions of the existing Creditview Road, Fairhill Avenue and the former Highway No. 7, will no longer be required for road purposes. A by-law is required to stop up and close these parcels, declare them surplus and authorize their disposal.

Committee of Council will consider this matter on November 23, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers, Brampton City Hall, at the address noted below. Anyone wishing to be heard regarding this matter should contact, or make written comments to be received in the Clerk's Office on or before 4:30 p.m., November 22, 2011. In the event that the Committee chooses to defer consideration of the matter, no further public notice will be given.
