

DISPOSITION OF LAND

Transfer of Permanent Easement to Hydro One Brampton Networks Inc. Various properties

Pursuant to By-Law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus and dispose of the following easement rights over five municipal properties:

LANDS AFFECTED

- SE corner of Mayfield Road and McLaughlin Road North
- SE Corner of Mayfield Road and Orangeville Brampton Rail Access Group (OBRA) railway tracks
- NE corner of Torbram Road and Central Park Drive
- 125 McLaughlin Road North, south end of Gibson Park
- 125 McLaughlin Road North, NW corner of Gibson Park at CNR tracks

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Permanent easement rights are being conveyed to Hydro One Brampton over a small portion of five City properties for hydro installations.

Pursuant to By-law 191-2011, surplus declaration may be made by Delegated Authority. In this case, authority is delegated to the City Solicitor and the Commissioner of Community Services or the Commissioner of Community Services for the following circumstance:

- Surplus declaration for property or rights to be conveyed to a utility for installation/maintenance of services, or for property or rights to be conveyed to another government;
