

SURPLUS DECLARATION AND INTENT TO SELL LAND
Transfer / Release of Permanent Easement to the Regional Municipality of Peel
For Sanitary Sewer Purposes - 150 and 160 Central Park Drive

PURSUANT to By-law 160-2004, take notice that The Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus and dispose of the following municipal property:

LANDS AFFECTED

Part of Lot 5, Concession 4 EHS, designated as Part 1 on Plan 43R-33949
Also known as: 150 and 160 Central Park Drive

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Transfer of permanent easement to the Regional Municipality of Peel for the purposes of construction, operation, maintenance, inspection, alteration, removal, replacement, reconstruction and enlargement and repairing of the Region's sanitary sewer pipe.

The City's Delegation of Authority By-law 191-2011, authorizes delegation of authority to the City Solicitor and the Commissioner of the operating department, in this case, the Commissioner of Works and Transportation, in connection with the following real estate related activity:

- Surplus declaration for property or rights to be conveyed to a utility for installation/maintenance of services, or for property rights to be conveyed to another government.
- Disposal of surplus property or rights at current market value of \$50,000 or less to be conveyed to a utility for installation/maintenance of services, or for property or rights to be conveyed to another government.
