

Notice of Intention to Amend Sign By-law 399-2002

Pursuant to Procedure By-Law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that The Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to consider an amendment to the Sign By-law 399-2002, as amended re:

Home Occupation Signs

Based on a delegation to the Committee of Council, City staff is recommending an amendment to the Sign By-law:

- to increase the size of a home occupation sign to 0.35 sq. m (3.75 sq. ft.) from the current 0.15 sq. m. (1.6 sq. ft.)
- to require that the sign be attached to the main floor of the dwelling
- to require that the sign be non-illuminated and not consist of a backlit box sign.

Planning, Design & Development Committee will consider this matter on **February 6, 2012** at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, City Hall, at the address below.
