ONLINE RECREATION REGISTRATION AND THEATRE TICKET RESERVATIONS TEMPORARILY UNAVAILABLE

BRAMPTON – The City of Brampton’s online registration system for Parks and Recreation programs and ticket reservations for City Theatre is currently unavailable as it is undergoes necessary preventative maintenance. The public is encouraged to use one of the five other methods of payment for Recreation programs including:

1. Drop by in person to any City of Brampton Recreation Centre. For a listing, visit www.brampton.ca
2. Drop off a completed registration form at any City of Brampton Recreation Centre.
3. Fax a completed registration form to 905-874-2396. Forms are available in the Parks and Recreation Brochure or by visiting www.brampton.ca
4. Register by phone using your credit card at 905-874-3388.
5. Mail in your completed registration form to:

For City Theatre shows, customers are urged to visit www.rosetheatre.ca or call 905-874-2800 to book tickets. Shakespeare in the Square is a pay-what-you-can series offered in June and July.

The proactive maintenance should take approximately three weeks to complete however other online applications for accessing City of Brampton services are still available. Commonly used online applications not affected by the maintenance include:

- obtaining parking permission to park on City streets
- searching and applying for current municipal jobs
- paying for traffic tickets
- information about current transit schedules.

The public will be notified once the maintenance is completed and these applications are again available online.
