**BRAMPTON, ON:** The City of Brampton will hold its Council Inauguration on Monday, December 6, 2010 at the Rose Theatre Brampton, where Mayor Susan Fennell and Members of Brampton City Council will be formally sworn into office for the 2010-2014 term.

All members of the public and media are invited to attend.

Seating in the theatre will be provided to the public on a first-come, first-served basis; additional viewing will be provided in the rotunda via a closed-circuit television feed.

Musical entertainment will be provided by the Jazz Mechanics, harpist Andrew Chan, and dhol drummers from the Goonjan Musical Group.

Members of Council will be escorted to their seats by the Knights of Columbus; the Town Crier, and Army, Navy and Sea cadets will also participate in the evening's proceedings.

Following the Inauguration, light refreshments will be provided.
