City Hall

Brampton City Hall, the Small Business Enterprise Centre and the City's Recreation Office will be closed Friday, July 1 for Canada Day. As a result, a number of City services will be unavailable or will operate under reduced service levels.

Residents will not be able to apply in person for marriage licences, pay parking fines or apply for building permits during this time. For online options please visit www.brampton.ca

Several services will continue to operate normally, including: Fire and Emergency Services, City of Brampton works yards and By-law Enforcement. Most recreation facilities are open over the holiday. Canada Day Celebration Road Closures

On July 1, sections of certain roads near the Powerade Centre will be closed to traffic to accommodate Canada Day celebrations. From 10 am to midnight closures will include:

- Kennedy Road from First Gulf Boulevard/Hartford Trail to Derry Road
- Kennedy Road from Steeles Avenue to First Gulf Boulevard/Hartford Trail (southbound lanes only)
- Hartford Trail from Steeles Avenue to Kennedy Road

Brampton Transit – Free Service All Day

Brampton Transit will be offering free service all day, including free shuttle service from four pick-up and drop-off locations to the Canada Day celebration at the Powerade Centre.

- Bramalea Terminal
- Orion Gate (NE corner of Steeles Avenue and Resolution Road)
- Sheridan College
- Bramalea GO Station

Buses depart from each location at 10 am, operating approximately every 15-20 minutes.

Brampton Transit, schedule for the Canada Day Weekend will be:

- Friday, July 1, 2011: Sunday/Holiday Service
- Saturday, July 2, 2011: Saturday Service
- Sunday, July 3, 2011: Sunday/Holiday Service

It is illegal to set off fireworks on sidewalks, streets, parks or any other public area.
