Brampton City Hall, the Small Business Enterprise Centre and the City's Parks and Recreation Office will be closed from noon on Friday, December 24, until 8:30 am on Tuesday, January 4. As a result, a number of City services will be unavailable or will operate under reduced service levels until the New Year.

During this time, residents will not be able to conduct business in person at City Hall. However, they can still apply for marriage licences, pay parking fines, apply for building permits or apply for employment with the City through the online portal at www.brampton.ca
