Fireworks Safety

There are no City of Brampton hosted fireworks displays on Victoria Day.

Victoria Day is one of the four days during the year when personal fireworks are allowed in the City of Brampton. Residents are reminded that in order to hold a personal fireworks display on your property, you must have a lot that is a minimum of 60 feet wide at the front. It is illegal to set off fireworks on sidewalks, streets, parks or any other public area.
