

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE (PIC)

Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study for Improvements of Wanless Drive Creditview Road to Mississauga Road - Part A (PIC No. 2) and Mississauga Road to Winston Churchill Boulevard - Part B (PIC No. 1)

The Study

The City of Brampton is conducting a Class Environment Assessment (EA) for improvements to Wanless Drive from Creditview Road to Mississauga Road (Part A) and from Mississauga Road to Winston Churchill Boulevard (Part B), see map. In order to best address operational deficiencies and the need for additional east-west transportation capacity in the area, a number of alternatives will be examined as part of the study including the potential widening of Wanless Drive to four lanes, cross-sectional elements, intersection improvements and traffic operations, and the overall impact of improvements on the social, cultural and natural environments.

The Process

The study is being carried out in accordance with the planning and design process for Schedule 'C' projects as outlined in the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended in 2011), which is approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.

The Mount Pleasant Secondary Plan Area Transportation Master Plan (2009) has completed Phase 1 (need and justification) and Phase 2 (alternative solutions) of the Class EA process for the widening of Wanless Drive to four through lanes from Creditview Road to Mississauga Road. This Study will satisfy Phase 3 (alternative designs) and Phase 4 (Environmental Study Report) of the Class EA process for Wanless Drive from Creditview Road to Mississauga Road (Part A), and Phases 1 to 4 of the Class EA process for Wanless Drive from Mississauga Road to Winston Churchill Boulevard (Part B).

A key component of the study will be consultation with interested stakeholders (public and agencies) at Public Information Centres (PICs).

Public Information Centre

A Public Information Centre have been arranged for Creditview Road to Mississauga Road - Part A (PIC No. 2) and Mississauga Road to Winston Churchill Boulevard - Part B (PIC No. 1):

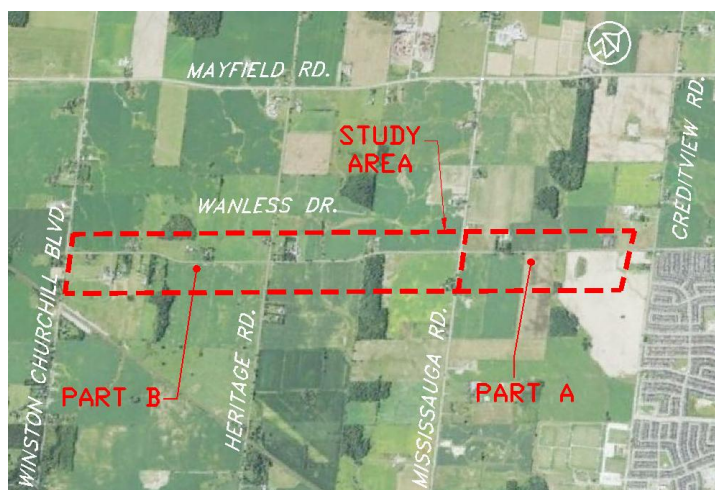

Following the PIC, the study findings will be reviewed in light of comments received and the preferred design (Part A) and preferred solution (Part B) will be confirmed or modified.
