Re: February 8th Meeting on Traffic Calming Study

Dear Resident,

Through the City of Brampton's ongoing efforts to ensure the safety and quality of life for its residents, **Fletchers Creek Boulevard** has been selected for the development of a neighbourhood traffic calming plan in accordance with the Neighbourhood Traffic Management Guide approved by City Council in 2007.

Traffic calming combines mainly physical measures aimed at:

- reducing the negative effects of motor vehicle use
- changing driver behaviour
- improving overall neighbourhood safety.

Designed to slow traffic, traffic calming measures may include increased enforcement, driver education and the addition of features like reduced lane widths or textured roadways. Each measure is selected based on its effectiveness at addressing existing traffic problems within the neighbourhood.

Developing a neighbourhood traffic calming plan involves examining traffic data, reviewing road characteristics and, most importantly, seeking input from you as residents. A kick-off public meeting is planned for:
