Driveway Access


Driveway access may be interrupted, this inconvenience will be kept to a minimum. If you are unable to enter your driveway due to construction, please park your vehicle on an adjacent side street or elsewhere in order to accommodate construction activities.

Parking

All parking signs and regulations must be obeyed when parking on adjacent streets. The *2 am to 6 am Parking Prohibited By-law* and the *Parking in Excess of 3 hours By-law* will be waived for residents unable to access their driveway. Vehicles impeding the construction will be tagged and towed by the City's Parking Enforcement. **Please contact 311 about the waiving of the above by-laws to ensure that your vehicle is not tagged and to request permission to park on City Streets**

Encroachment

Construction may affect private lawn features within the city boulevard. Homeowners are responsible for removing items such as **gardens, lawn sprinklers, hedges, driveway timber/concrete edges, etc.** to avoid unintentional damage due to the construction. **Sprinkler systems and lawn features mentioned above that are damaged by the construction work will not be repaired.** For further clarification on about encroachments on City-Owned Property, please contact 311.



Network Outages

Due to the nature of the work, it is common for network outages to occur on telephone, cable and/or internet services. Please note that any outages that are discovered Monday to Friday between 7 am and 3:30 pm can be reported to the City of Brampton at 311. Outages discovered outside of these times should be reported to your service provider.

Sod

Grass boulevards damaged by construction will be repaired. Please note, only the boulevard area impacted by the construction will be repaired as the City does not provide full boulevard replacement. In an effort to keep the City "Clean and Green", we appreciate your efforts to water and maintain the new sod.
