In order to be considered for a career as a Firefighter, you must meet the following **minimum qualifications** to apply:

- High School Diploma;
- Graduate of the Pre-Service Fire Fighter Education & Training Program or NFPA 1001 - Fire Fighter I & II certified;
- Valid Ontario Class "DZ" drivers license (by the interview stage);
- Valid and current First Aid and CPR certificate;
- Successful completion of the Brock University screening tests in one day;
- Meet all employment conditions as required by the City of Brampton.

### ***Please read carefully***

To complete the Brock University Firefighter screening tests, to be held on November 13, 19, 20, 26, 27, December 3, 4, you **must pre-register by 4:00 pm on Friday, November 4, 2011**. Transportation costs and the Brock Firefighter Screening Services fee will be the responsibility of the applicant. Candidates must successfully complete all six tests in one day (no earlier than May 2011). To register for the 1) Medical exam, 2) CPAT test, 3) Clinical test, 4) Aptitude Exam, 5) Acrophobia test and 6) Swim test please go to [www.brockfirefighter.com](http://www.brockfirefighter.com). To purchase the CPS prep manual (\$25), or to participate in a CPAT orientation (\$100), please contact Brock University at [firefighter@brocku.ca](mailto:firefighter@brocku.ca).

Applicants meeting all of the above minimum qualifications are required to bring their application package including: 1) Job application, 2) Resume, 3) First Aid and CPR certificates, 4) Brock Firefighter Screening test certificate and 5) Proof of education to the Brock University Screening Test. Candidates who are successful with the Brock University testing are required to pay a \$25.00 application fee at time of submission. Brock University will forward qualified candidates to the City of Brampton. If applicants have valid certificates (tests completed after April 2011) please email [firefighter@brocku.ca](mailto:firefighter@brocku.ca) to have your application and tests results forwarded to City of Brampton (\$25).

Please be advised, the City of Brampton uses email to communicate with their applicants for open job competitions.
