## Service Improvements

Effective Monday, June 28, Route 3 McLaughlin Sunday schedule will be adjusted to service the Flower City Seniors Centre.

Northbound trips departing from Shoppers World Terminal beginning at 8:00 am to 6:00 pm will now enter the Flower City Community Campus.

Southbound trips departing from Heart Lake Terminal beginning at 8:02 am to 6:02 pm will now enter the Flower City Community Campus.

All routes will maintain the regular 40 minute frequency.

## A Better Ride is on the Way

Brampton Transit is testing a next stop announcement system on its buses. This new automated system will enhance overall customer service and improve accessibility.

An LED sign at the front of the bus will display the next bus stop location preparing riders for departure. An audible voice will announce the stop at the same time. As the bus approaches each stop, customers waiting outside will also hear the system announce the name and destination of the route.

The system will be implemented on all buses by September.



## PRESTO is Coming!

In the coming months, you will notice a new machine on every Brampton Transit bus – this is the new PRESTO fare payment device.

PRESTO is an electronic fare system that lets transit users move between and within transit systems with ease. With a PRESTO card, you can tap the device, and in seconds, the appropriate fare will be deducted from your balance on the card. No more tickets or change required!

### How It Works:

1. Buy a PRESTO card and load money onto it.
2. Board a participating transit system and tap the PRESTO card onto the fare payment device.
3. The fare for that transit system is deducted from the card balance.

Beginning this September, Brampton Transit offers Züm, Brampton's first Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) service, which will run along Queen Street from downtown Brampton to York University.

### Here's how Züm will improve your daily ride:

- **Limited stops:** Züm has limited stops that are further apart – reducing travel times.
- **Frequency:** Züm will run every 7 to 10 minutes during peak hours and approximately every 15 minutes during off-peak hours.
- **Reliability:** Züm vehicles are equipped with technology that can influence traffic signals – improving schedule reliability, even in mixed traffic.
- **Advanced communication:** Real-time schedule information is available at all station stops and transit terminals – so you'll always know when your next bus will arrive.
- **Seamless integration:** Züm and Brampton Transit's conventional services, work together, so you can move between the two services quickly and easily – using the same transfers and fares!
