PRESTO is here!

This state-of-the-art electronic fare system lets you move between and within transit systems with ease - a PRESTO card makes commuting easier! Load money onto your card (called e-purse), or put your weekly or monthly pass directly onto the card. You never have to worry about losing your paper pass or transfer again. It's all stored on the card!

Customers who register their cards also benefit. If your card is lost or stolen, it can be replaced and the value restored.
