**Do the
Transit Wave**

To ensure that the operator sees you while waiting for your bus, do the transit wave. Step forward making yourself visible and raise your hand to signal to the operator that you would like to board that bus. This is especially important at stops that service more than one route or transit provider.

If the bus that is approaching is not yours, take a step back to let the operator know that you are not waiting for that bus.
