## Transit Talk

Learn how to decipher the destination signs on the buses so you end up in the right place!

**Short Turn:** Bus will be turning back before the end of its scheduled route, due to schedule or operational issues.

**On Detour:** Bus route is operating on a detour.

**Last Trip:** Bus is operating on the last scheduled trip of that day for that route.

**Full-Next Bus:** The bus has reached passenger capacity. Please wait for the next bus.

**No Pick Ups:** Bus is dropping off passengers only, due to an operational or schedule adherence issue.

## Rapid Transit is coming... Züm around Brampton beginning this fall

Starting in September, there's a new ride in town. Züm is Brampton Transit's new Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) service. The first line, Züm Queen Street, will run from downtown Brampton to York University.

Whether you're out shopping, commuting to work or headed to school, Züm puts you in control. With frequent service throughout the day, and a peak frequency of 7-10 minutes, Züm is reliable. Improved technologies and a wide range of customer service features also enhance service; access real-time information by phone, text or web.

Following the Züm Queen Street launch, Züm services begin along Main Street in 2011 and Steeles Avenue in 2012.
