Holiday Schedules

Canada Day - Wednesday, July 1
Civic Holiday – Monday, August 3

Brampton Transit will be operating on a Sunday/Holiday schedule for both of these holidays. Transit stores will be closed.

*** Route 77 Highway 7 will operate on a Saturday schedule on Canada Day.**

Smog Days

Summer means warm weather, BBQ's and unfortunately, smog days. Here is some information about smog and suggestions on what you can do to help improve our air.

What is smog?

Smog is a mixture of many pollutants, but the two main ingredients are ground-level ozone (O3) and particulate matter (PM). Smog can form in almost any climate where industries or cities release large amounts of air pollution. However, it is worse during periods of warmer, sunnier weather.

What can I do?

The easiest ways to reduce our contribution to smog are to reduce our use of gas-powered vehicles and conserve our energy use. When possible, use public transportation instead of your car. You could also walk or ride your bicycle, as long as smog levels are not too high.

Did you know?

The average cost of driving one kilometre in Canada is 46 cents per person. On public transit, this cost drops to 12 cents.

BRAMPTON FARMERS' MARKET

This yearly event runs every Saturday morning from 7:00 am – 1:00 pm, June 20 to October 10. Enjoy fresh produce from some of the area's local producers!

Every Saturday, Main Street North between Theatre Lane and Queen Street, and Main Street South between Queen Street and John Street will be closed, turning the downtown into a vibrant marketplace. During this time the Route 2 Main will be on temporary detour.



CANADA DAY

On Wednesday, July 1, Brampton Transit will be running a FREE shuttle service to and from the Canada Day celebration at Donald M. Gordon Chinguacousy Park.

Shuttle service will begin at 2:30 pm, departing every 30 minutes until 12:00 am. Check the schedules posted at each location. Shuttles will depart from:

- Shoppers World Transit Terminal
- Downtown Brampton Transit Terminal
- Trinity Common Transit Terminal
- Mount Pleasant GO Station
- Fortino's Plaza (55 Mountainash Rd.)

CARABRAM JULY 10 – 12

Take the Carabram shuttle around the city and learn about the world! Visit 14 pavilions, with daily shuttle service running all weekend. Show your Carabram passport when you board the shuttle or any regular service bus and travel for free. Passports can be purchased at Trinity Common Terminal, Shopper's World Terminal, Downtown Terminal or Bramalea Transit Centre during regular store hours. Shuttles run every 60 minutes, in a clockwise and counter-clockwise direction.
