- Select your date and time of travel.
- Choose your travel options, such as fastest trip or a school route.
- Click on Show Trip Plan.

Within seconds, a detailed trip itinerary is displayed and you are on your way to moving across the city. There are options to see a return trip, earlier or later route times, or start planning your next trip.

A state-of-the-art electronic fare system that lets you move between and within transit systems with ease, a PRESTO card will make commuting easier! You can load money onto the card (called e-purse), or put your weekly or monthly pass directly onto the card. You will never have to worry about losing your paper pass or transfer again. It's all stored on the card!

Customers who register their cards also benefit. If your card is lost or stolen, it can be replaced and the value restored.
