

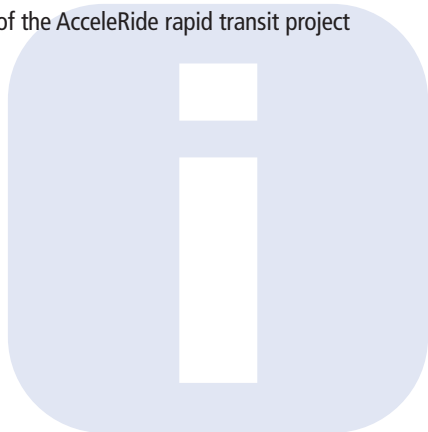

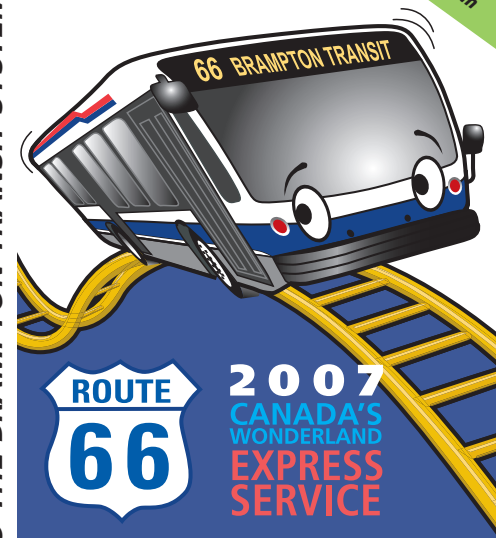

**BRAMPTON TRANSIT WEEKLY PASSES NOW QUALIFY FOR 15.5% TAX CREDIT**

On March 19, 2007 the Federal Government expanded its tax credit eligibility criteria to include weekly passes. To make a claim you should retain your passes and receipts for verification purposes. You must have 4 consecutive weekly passes in a 28-day period. **ALL LIGHTS ARE GREEN FOR BRAMPTON'S BUS RAPID TRANSIT PROJECT**

On March 6, 2007 the Federal Government announced that Brampton Transit's AcceleRide project is eligible for up to \$95 million in capital funding. With commitments now in place from both the federal and provincial government, the newly opened AcceleRide Project Office can now begin the detailed planning and implementation of higher order rapid transit.

The AcceleRide BRT initiative addresses transportation needs identified at both local and regional (GTA-wide) levels. It complements ongoing Brampton Transit initiatives and the City's long-term vision for transportation in the City including (i) transit priority measures on Queen Street East, Steeles Avenue, Bovaird Drive, and routes connecting to Pearson Airport and the Airport Corporate Centre; (ii) improved inter-regional and inter-municipal transit service connections and integration; (iii) improved transit access to and from transit terminals in the City, including GO Stations; (iv) expanding express services linking key residential areas to GO and Brampton Transit terminals across the City; and (v) expanding/improving transit services in growth areas, and connections to employment zones.
