## Transit etiquette

Keep these simple things in mind when riding the bus to make everyone's trip more enjoyable.

**Don't block the exits.** When the bus comes to a stop, ensure the doors are clear so that people can exit comfortably.

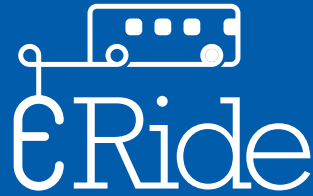
**Courtesy seats** at the front of the bus are for senior citizens and persons with disabilities. Please make these seats available when requested.

**Personal audio devices** are for your enjoyment only. Keep the volume at a reasonable level.

**Garbage** does not belong on the floor. Please use the garbage bags at the front of the bus to dispose of your trash.

**Cell phones** are used for private conversations. Keep your voice down, remember you're not riding alone.

**Large bags** should be placed on your lap or on the floor in front of you. Your bag does not need its own seat.

Here's how to use it:

- Visit [www.bramptontransit.com](http://www.bramptontransit.com) and click on eRide.
- Enter your starting point. This could be your address, a city landmark, or any intersection.
- Enter your destination point.
- Select your date and time of travel.
- Choose your travel options, such as fastest trip or a school route.
- Click on Show Trip Plan.

Within seconds, a detailed trip itinerary is displayed and you are on your way to moving across the city.
