

Gripping drama on stage July 5 to 27 at Rose

BRAMPTON— It's a gripping drama that lets the audience in on an intriguing process usually kept secret, and it opens at the Rose Theatre's Studio Two on July 5.

The Summer Theatre Series' second installment, *12 Angry Men*, takes the stage and delivers an unforgettable experience when a jury is charged with deliberating the fate of a teenage boy accused of killing his father.

Directed by Danny Harvey, who together with Rob Woodcock produced the 2013 summer season, the play is a spellbinding look at the how the jury considers the evidence in a murder that could hand a death sentence to the accused.

With a cast of 13, Harvey said the smaller space of Studio Two will help create a tense atmosphere as the story unravels, and will bring the audience into a shared emotional space with the characters.

It's a riveting piece of theatre that will spark discussion and contemplation, in addition to providing top-quality entertainment, he said.

The play runs July 5 to 27 with an opening night reception. Each Wednesday features a post-show talk back with members of the cast.
