



Suresh ushers in 2011 with marathon dance

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Mississauga's serial Guinness World Record setter Suresh Joachim will attempt to reclaim his Longest Dance Marathon title during Brampton's New Year's Eve celebrations.

The current record, set in 2008, is 108 hours, which broke Joachim's previous record set in 2005 at Dixie Value Mall.

Joachim, who has broken more than 60 world records, aims to dance non-stop for 110 hours. Dancing to 1,650 songs, he must keep his feet moving at all times with pauses of no more than 30 seconds between dances.

Joachim has broken many dancing world records, including couple dancing with Tiffany Lesko for 31 hours, moon-walking 49.252 kilometres in 24 hours and break-dancing with a team for 24 hours.

Joachim will attempt his feat at Brampton Rose Theatre, beginning Dec. 27 at 8:30 a.m. with a finish time predicted for Dec. 31 at 10:30 p.m.

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
