

Purpose and Effect

The City of Brampton is proposing to establish the Main Street South Heritage Conservation District under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act.* You are invited to attend a Public Open House about the Main Street South Heritage Conservation District Plan.

The Main Street South Heritage Conservation District Study was approved by Council in September 2014. In addition to approving the District Study, Council directed staff to proceed with the next stage of establishing the District, which includes preparing the Main Street South Heritage Conservation District Plan, designation by-law and planning amendments. The overall objective of a District Plan is to provide policies and guidelines that will assist in the protection and enhancement of the cultural heritage values of the district.

This Public Open House offers an opportunity for the public to learn about and discuss the draft Main Street South HCD Plan. Learn what the designation of an HCD means for you and how the HCD Plan provides guidance to property owners and tenants in and around a district who wish to make modifications to their properties.

Comments received at the Public Open House will be considered prior to finalizing the District Plan, which will be presented to the Brampton Heritage Board for endorsement and then to Council for approval following further public consultation.
