Please include the following materials in your PDF to be eligible for consideration:

1. Current CV

This is intended to give us a sense of your previous experience. If you are applying for the role of assistant, is perfectly acceptable to have only limited experience and be in the early stages of your artistic career.

2. Artist Bio

A max of 3-5 sentences.

3. Visual Support Material

A selection of 4-6 images of recent work, along with its name, year created, commissioning body and budget. If you are applying as an assistant, it is okay if the work shared is from your individual artistic practice rather than commissioned public artworks.

4. References

The name, job title, email address and phone number of two references you have previously worked with. Please also include a brief sentence or two about what you worked on together.
