Performing Arts Public Spaces include:

- Garden Square
- The Rose Patio
- Vivian Lane
- Any space accessible or visible to the public without tickets or registration, in person and online, where a Performing Arts event or program takes place

These guidelines apply to:

- All events, performances, presentations, and activities in Garden Square
- Garden Square screen content, including livestreams
- Performances arranged through or by the Performing Arts Division in any space accessible or visible to the public, without tickets or registration
- All content on Performing Arts public social media channels: YouTube, Facebook, Instagram, Twitter

The City of Brampton values inclusiveness, diversity, equity, and accessibility. We are committed to offering an accessible, safe, and barrier-free experience for all. Anyone in a Performing Arts Public Space is asked to be aware of their language and behaviour, and to ensure that these are not harming others. The Performing Arts programming and rentals teams are available to discuss details with artists and rental clients, as needed.
