



## **Notice of Public Meeting Proposed Development Charges By-Laws**

Notice is hereby published that City Council will hold a Public Meeting, pursuant to the *Development Charges Act, 1997*, on **Wednesday, May 22, 2019 at 9:30 a.m.** in the Council Chambers (4<sup>th</sup> Floor), City Hall, at the address below, to receive public input on a Background Study and related reports, in order to consider proposed new Development Charges By-Laws.

Pursuant to the *Development Charges Act, 1997*, municipalities are required to complete a Background Study and hold at least one Public Meeting before passage of a Development Charges By-law. The City of Brampton's current Development Charges By-laws will expire in August 2019.

Development charges are levied against new development, and are a primary source of funding for growth-related capital expenditures. The 2019 Development Charges Background Study relates to the provision of all eligible Development Charges Services (i.e., General Government, Library Services, Fire Services, Recreation, Public Works, Parking, Transit and Roads & Related).

The draft Development Charges By-laws will be posted to this page on or before Wednesday, May 8, 2019, and available for review in the City Clerk's Office between 8:30 am and 4:30 pm.

Anyone interested in speaking to this matter at the Public Meeting or making written submissions should contact the City Clerk's Office, at the address below, no later than 4:30 pm on May 21, 2019. Written comments received prior to the meeting and submissions made at the Public Meeting will be considered by Council prior to the enactment of a new Development Charges By-laws on a date subsequent to the Public Meeting.
