



Notice of Master Plan – Brampton Mobility Plan

The study

The City of Brampton has completed an update of its transportation master plan, the Brampton Mobility Plan (BMP). The BMP outlines transportation policies, infrastructure investments, and programs aimed at supporting the movement of people and goods within the city and establishes a long-term vision for Brampton's transportation network until the year 2051.

The process

The Brampton Mobility Plan was prepared in accordance with the Master Plan process (Approach #1) for Municipal Class Environmental Assessments under the Environmental Assessment Act. The study satisfies Phase 1 (Identify Problem and Opportunity) and Phase 2 (Identify and Evaluate Alternative Solutions) of the environmental assessment process. Two rounds of public and stakeholder consultation were held over the course of the plan development.

The Brampton Mobility Plan addresses need and justification at a broad level, documents the planning and decision-making process, and recommends infrastructure projects, policies, and programs. Infrastructure projects within the plan are anticipated to require further detailed studies and approvals prior to construction.

The Transportation Master Plan Report

The Brampton Mobility Plan report will be available on the City of Brampton's website for a 30-day public review at www.brampton.ca/mobilityplan until November 14, 2025, in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Class EA process.
