to Zoning By-Law 270-2004 An Interim Control By-Law applicable to part of the area subject

By-law to be in effect for a period of time to prohibit the use of land, building or structures in a defined area, while the municipality undertakes a study in respect of the land use planning policies in the subject area; and, WHEREAS the Planning Act permits the municipality to pass an Interim Control

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton seeks to control development of residential lands within the City of Brampton in order to complete a study with respect to land use planning policies that apply to this area.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- within the following residential zones, including any such parent zone with a special section: This Interim Control By-Law applies to all lands, buildings and structures
- R1C(1), R1D, R1E-x, R1F-x, R2A, R2A(1) R2A(2), R2B, R2B(1) R2C, R2D-x, R2E-x, RE1, RE2, and RHm1. R1A, R1A(1), R1A(2), R1A(3), R1B, RIB(1), R1B(2), R1B(3), R1C
- 2 resulting in an increase in gross floor area greater than 15 percent of the additions to existing residential buildings or structures erected thereon The lands subject to this Interim Control By-law shall not have any existing building.
- This by-law shall be in effect from March 1, 2013 until February 28, 2014
