BY-LAW 306-2003

An Interim Control By-law applicable to Part of the area subject to By-law 151-88.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Except as provided for in Section 1.1, Section 1.2 and Section 1.3, the lands described as Part of Lots 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17 Concession 5 WHS and Lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and Parts of Lots 8, 9, and 10 Concession 6 WHS as outlined on Schedule A to this by-law shall not have any buildings or structures erected thereon, except for those existing on the date of enactment of this by-law.
 - 1.1 A place of worship shall only be permitted on the lands described as Part of East Half of Lot 11, Concession 5 WHS as outlined on Schedule A to this by-law.
 - 1.2 A public utility comprised of a water reservoir and pumping station operated by the Region of Peel shall be permitted on the lands within Lots 7, 8, 9, and 10, Concession 5 WHS as outlined on Schedule A to this by-law provided that all the requisite approvals under the Environmental Assessment Act are obtained.
 - 1.3 The lands described as Part of Lot 10, Concession 5 WHS which comprise an area of 38 acres (15.3 hectares) and referenced as the "Lands Subject to Specific Exemption From Interim Control By-law 306-2003, as amended by by-law 355-2004" as outlined on Schedule A to this by-law shall only permit a Golf Driving Range.
2. This by-law shall be in effect from October 13, 2004 to October 12, 2005.
