A by-law to authorize the use
of electronic vote tabulating
equipment at City of Brampton
Municipal Elections



WHEREAS Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* provides that the council of a municipality may pass a by-law authorizing the use of electronic vote tabulating equipment for the purpose of counting votes at municipal elections;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Optical scan vote tabulating equipment shall be used at all voting locations, including advance vote locations, for City of Brampton municipal elections, and
2. In addition to optical scan vote tabulating equipment, touch screen vote tabulating equipment shall be used at all advance vote locations for City of Brampton Municipal Elections, and may be used at selected locations on Election Day as determined by the City Clerk.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 10TH day of February 2010.
