BY-LAW

Number 278-2010

To declare surplus and
authorize the transfer, release
and abandonment of an
easement for hydro purposes

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that an easement for hydro purposes (the "Easement") over the lands described as being Part of Lot 5, Concession 1 EHS, designated as Parts 23 and 28 on Plan 43R-24233 comprising of part of the lands and premises described in PIN No. 14033-0240 (LT), (the "Lands") be released to the owner of the Lands;

AND WHEREAS the Easement over the Lands was conveyed to the City and Brampton Hydro-Electric Commission in 1984 for nominal consideration for hydro purposes;

AND WHEREAS Hydro One Brampton Networks Inc. released the Easement to the Owner of the Lands on July 12, 2007 and the City has now determined that it no longer requires the Easement over the Lands;


AND WHEREAS the procedures required by By-Law 160-2004 have been followed;


AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Easement over the Lands is hereby declared to be surplus.
2. The transfer, release and abandonment of the Easement over the Lands for nominal consideration to the owner of the fee simple lands is hereby authorized.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 11th day of August, 2010.
