WHE impo	EREAS subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> , R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has sed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;
muni apply	WHEREAS , pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the <i>Planning Act</i> , the Council of a cipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> does not to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are gnated in the by-law;
subs	WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to ection 50(7) of the <i>Planning</i> Act, on the lands described below for the purpose of thing maintenance easements is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;
