

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

## **BY-LAW**

Number 23-2014

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M – 1883

**WHEREAS** subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

**AND WHEREAS,** pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

**AND WHEREAS**, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning* Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating maintenance easements and creating semi-detached dwelling unit lots is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

**NOW THEREFORE**, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:
  - City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of Lots 347, 348, 349, 350, 351, 352 on Registered Plan 43M-1883

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire at the end of the business day on January 29, 2017.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 29th day
