By-law to provide for advance
votes to be held for the 2014
City of Brampton Municipal
Election and to repeal By-law
84-2014

WHEREAS Section 43(1) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended* provides that the council of a municipality shall pass a by-law establishing one or more dates for an advance vote, and the hours during which voting places shall be open on that date or dates;

AND WHEREAS the advance voting dates and hours identified in By-law 84-2014 are to be replaced with the advance voting dates, hours and places specified in this by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That advance voting shall be held on the following dates and times, and at the following locations, with respect to the Municipal Election to be held on Monday, October 27, 2014:




2. That By-law 84-2014 is repealed.
