Number 267-2014

**A By-law to amend Mobile Licensing By-law 67-2014,
regarding the continued closure of the Taxicab Priority List
(Schedule IV)**

Recitals:

The recitals listed in Mobile Licensing By-law 67-2014, as amended are adopted as recitals for this by-law amendment;

Section 156 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, provides that a municipality may limit the number of taxicab licences or any class of them; and

The Council for the City of Brampton considers it desirable that no further additional names be added to the taxicab Priority List under the new Mobile Licensing By-law 67-2014.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Mobile Licensing By-law 67-2014, as amended, is further amended by deleting section 44 in Schedule 4 and replacing it with the following:

“44. The Licence Issuer shall not accept any new Application for a Taxicab or Accessible Taxicab Owner’s Plate, from any Person not on the Priority List, nor shall any new names be added to the Priority List, for an additional period of five years commencing on November 9th, 2014.”


2. This by-law comes into force and effect on November 9, 2014.
