

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 369-2014

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M – 1946

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning* Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating maintenance easements, semi-detached dwelling unit lots and townhouse dwelling unit lots is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of Lots 1 - 5 inclusive, 38, 40 - 43 inclusive, 45 - 47 inclusive and Blocks 165, 166, 192 and 230 on Registered Plan 43M-1946.

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire at the end of the business day on December 10, 2017.

READ a **FIRST**, **SECOND** and **THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this 10th day of December, 2014.
