**A By-law to amend Traffic By-law 93-93,
To remove the flat fee charge of \$20.00 required
to park in a municipal facility in conjunction with
New Year's Eve Celebrations**

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, as amended, c.25, s. 391 (1)* provides that a municipality may pass a by-law to impose fees or charges;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Brampton wishes to no longer impose a \$20 flat fee to park at a municipal facility for the hours around New Year's Eve celebrations;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law 93-93, as amended, is further amended by DELETING the following from Section 57 (7) of Traffic By-law 93-93:

(7) Barrier gate controlled

(a) No person shall park any motor vehicle in or on any municipal parking lot named and located in Columns 1 and 2 respectively of Schedule XXVII of this by-law during the hours of operation set out in Column 5 of said Schedule, unless:

(i) the fee is paid to the parking lot attendant or parking machine in accordance with the rate set out in Column 3 of said Schedule XXVII except that upon entrance to the lot from 5:00 p.m. on New Year's Eve to 1:00 a.m. on New Year's Day, a flat rate fee of \$20.00 is paid upon entry, said flat rate payment valid until the commencement of the first working day following New Year's Day;

(ii) the motor vehicle has a valid monthly permit purchased for the fee prescribed in Column 4 of said Schedule XXVII and the terms and conditions outlined regarding the use of the permit are adhered to.

(b) Despite sub-section (a), from 5:00 pm on New Year's Eve to 1:00 am on New Year's Day, a flat rate fee of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) will apply upon entry to the parking lots located in Columns 1 and

2 which payments shall be valid until the commencement of the first working day following New Year's Day.

2. By-law 93-93, as amended, is further amended by ADDING the following to Section 57 (7) of Traffic By-law 93-93:

(7) **Barrier gate controlled**


No person shall park any motor vehicle in or on any municipal parking lot named and located in Columns 1 and 2 respectively of Schedule XXVII of this by-law during the hours of operation set out in Column 5 of said Schedule, unless:


- (a) the fee is paid to the parking lot attendant or parking machine in accordance with the rate set out in Column 3 of said Schedule XXVII;
- (b) the motor vehicle has a valid monthly permit purchased for the fee prescribed in Column 4 of said Schedule XXVII and the terms and conditions outlined regarding the use of the permit are adhered to.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL, this 25TH day of February, 2015.
