



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 220-2015

To prevent the application of part lot control
to part of Registered Plan 43M - 1966
and to repeal By-Law 189-2015

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the lots and blocks in relation to plan 43M-1966 as they are identified in By-law 189-2015, a by-law to prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M-1966, are referenced inaccurately and is to be repealed and replaced in order to reference said lots and blocks correctly as they are identified herein;


NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. THAT By-Law 189-2015 is hereby repealed.
2. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:
The whole of Lots 13, 14, 49, 51, 52 and Blocks 58, 59 and 61 on Registered Plan 43M-1966.
3. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire at the end of the business day on the 16th day of September 2018.


READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 16th day of September, 2015.
