BY-LAW

Number 38 - 2016

To stop up and permanently close and declare surplus portions of the original Countryside Drive road allowance between Torbram Road and Airport Road

WHEREAS it is expedient to stop up and permanently close, as public highway, and declare surplus certain portions of the original Countryside Drive road allowance;

WHEREAS these portions of the original Countryside Drive road allowance are no longer required for road purposes, and serve no other municipal purposes except for a storm sewer under part thereof;

AND WHEREAS the procedures of required by By-Law 160-2004, as amended, have been followed;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Those portions of the original Countryside Drive road allowance lying between Lots 15 and 16, Concession 6, East Hurontario Street, designated as Parts 1, 2 and 5 on Plan 43R-37035 are hereby stopped up and permanently closed as public highway, and with the exception of a permanent storm sewer easement over Part 5 on the said Plan, declared surplus to the requirements of the City of Brampton.
