BY-LAW

Number 52 - 2016

To amend By-law 84-2008, as amended,
to appoint a Chief Administrative Officer

WHEREAS By-law 84-2008 provides for the appointment of officials of The Corporation of the City of Brampton;

WHEREAS By-law 93-2015, which amended By-law 84-2008, was passed on April 22, 2015 to appoint Marilyn Ball as Acting Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) until a permanent CAO has been appointed; and


WHEREAS at a Special Meeting of Council, held on April 8, 2016, Council passed Resolution C109-2016 to appoint Harry Schlange as the permanent Chief Administrative Officer (also known as City Manager) for The Corporation of the City of Brampton effective on May 30, 2016;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


1. That By-law 84-2008, as amended, is further amended by deleting section 1 and replacing it with the following:
 1. (1) That Harry Schlange be and is appointed as Chief Administrative Officer (also known as City Manager) and shall exercise all powers and duties of the position for all purposes under the *Municipal Act, 2001*, City By-laws and policies.
 - (2) Where the Chief Administrative Officer is absent from his duties for any reason, a Department Chief as designated in writing by the Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to act in the place of the Chief Administrative Officer and shall exercise all the powers and duties as set out in subsection (1).


2. Section 1 of this by-law shall come into force and effect at the beginning of the day on May 30, 2016.
