To amend By-law 399-2002, as amended,
The Sign By-law

WHEREAS it is essential for schools to communicate information to students, parents and the community; and

WHEREAS school properties are primarily located in residential neighbourhoods.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows.

THAT By-law 399-2002, as amended, is hereby further amended:


- 1) By changing subnote 11 in the chart within Schedule II GROUND SIGNS to read:


¹¹ An Electronic Variable Message Centre is permitted within a Class A ground sign provided it does not exceed 1/3 of the sign area and does not contain a flashing message or image. Where the message is of other than scrolling script, the frequency of an image change shall not be less than every 10 seconds. An Electronic Variable Message Centre shall be separated by a minimum distance of 36 m (118 ft) from a property zoned residential except where the sign is contained on a school property. Where an Electronic Variable Message Centre is located within 100 m (328 ft) of a property zoned residential, the sign shall be turned off between the hours of 10:00 pm and 7:00 am.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 27th day of April, 2016.
