

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 230 - 2016

To amend Mobile Licensing By-law 67-2014, regarding an increase of one model year to the number of model years an Accessible Vehicle may be registered as an Accessible Taxicab

Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001,* Section 11, provides that a municipality may regulate businesses for the health, safety and well being of persons;

Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001*, Part IV – Licenses, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws for licensing, regulating and governing any business wholly or partly carried on within a municipality;

Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001, Subsection 151 (1)*, provides that a municipality may provide for a system of licenses with respect to a business and may prohibit the carrying on or engaging in the business without a licence, refusing, revoking or suspending a licence, imposing conditions on a licence, regulating property used for a business that requires a licence and regulating persons carrying on a business that requires a licence; and

Whereas by Corporate Services Committee Recommendation CS118-2016, approved by Council Resolution C258-2016, the Council of the City of Brampton considers it desirable that an additional model year be granted to the owners of Accessible Taxicabs;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That Part XIV of Mobile Licensing By-law 67-2014, as amended, is further amended by DELETING subsection 35(8):
 - A Plate Owner may apply for an extension of up to 3 years on the model year for any Licence given under this By-law provided the appropriate fee is paid, the Taxicab or Accessible Taxicab meets all of the Motor Vehicle marking, equipment and maintenance provisions of this By-law, and the Motor Vehicle successfully completes all inspections as required by the Licence Issuer.
- 2. That Part XIV of Mobile Licensing By-law 67-2014, as amended, is further amended by ADDING subsection 35(8) (i) and (ii):

- 35(8) (i) A Plate Owner may apply for an extension of up to 3 years on the model year for a Motor Vehicle licensed under this By-law as a Taxicab provided the appropriate fee is paid, the Taxicab meets all of the Motor Vehicle marking, equipment and maintenance provisions of this By-law, and the Motor Vehicle successfully completes all inspections as required by the Licence Issuer.
 - (ii) A Plate Owner may apply for an extension of up to 4 years on the model year for a Motor Vehicle licensed under this By-law as an Accessible Taxicab provided the appropriate fee is paid, the Accessible Taxicab meets all of the Motor Vehicle marking, equipment and maintenance provisions of this By-law, and the Motor Vehicle successfully completes all inspections as required by the Licence Issuer.
