Number <u>41</u> - 2017

To amend By-Law 87-2016 and By-Law 88-2016, being By-Laws authorizing the Surplus Declaration and Disposal of easement rights over certain City owned properties along Dixie Road from Bovaird Drive East South to Orenda Road, to the Regional Municipality of Peel
