Number <u>68</u>-2017

A by-law to authorize the use of electronic vote tabulating equipment for City of Brampton Municipal Elections

WHEREAS Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* permits the council of a municipality to pass a by-law authorizing the use of electronic vote tabulating equipment such as voting machines, voting recorders or optical scanning vote tabulators for the purpose of counting votes at municipal elections;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Electronic vote tabulating equipment may be used for City of Brampton municipal elections at all voting locations on voting day and advance voting dates, as determined by the City Clerk;
