# TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

#### 1.0 Purpose:

The purpose of this amendment is to revise the policies of the Business Corridor designation by deleting Subsection 4.4.1.4.

#### 2.0 Location:

This amendment affects all lands within the Business Corridor designation of the Official Plan.

#### 3.0 Amendments and Policies Relative Thereto:

- 3.1 The document known as the Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area is hereby further amended:
- (1) by amending Section 4.4 <u>Employment</u>, to delete the following Subsection 4.4.1.4 in its entirety and renumbering the subsequent subsections:

#### **"4.4.1.4**

Business Corridor designations within or at the edge of large Residential designation areas may be permitted to accommodate integrated or mixed use commercial and residential uses, if determined to be appropriate and so indicated in the relevant Secondary Plan."
