BY-LAW

Number 178 -2017

To Execute a Licence Agreement to Holland Christian Homes Inc. on a portion of City owned land, being Kingknoll Park (Ward 4)

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is in the interest of the Corporation of the City of Brampton to execute a licence agreement with Holland Christian Homes Inc. ("HCH"), over an approximately 7-metre-wide strip of City owned land, being part of Kingknoll Park for a period of approximately two years, for the purposes of excavation, temporary working area and temporary storage of materials/equipment;

AND WHEREAS Realty Services ("Realty") does not have delegated authority under Delegation Authority By-Law 191-2011, as amended, to approve and execute the proposed licence agreement.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a Licence Agreement between the City of Brampton (the "City") and Holland Christian Homes Inc. for a licence to use approximately 0.21 acres of City owned lands, known as Kingknoll Park, at fair market value and conditional on Site Plan Approval, and all supplementary agreements as may be required in connection therewith, with content acceptable to the Commissioner of Public Works and Engineering and in a form acceptable to the City Solicitor, or designate.
